

## Brief History

The Anthropological Index Online (AIO) is published by the Royal Anthropological Institute (RAI) in cooperation with Anthropology Library and Research Centre, British Museum. Coverage period of records from 1957 to the present. The Anthropological Index Online has received generous financial support from the William Buller Fagg Charitable Trust. The retrospective online conversion of earlier records was made possible by grants from the Getty Foundation, ESRC (UK), the Mellon Trust, the Pilgrim Trust and the Marsh Christian Trust. The main work of the conversion, completed in 2000, was undertaken by the UK Higher Education Digitization Service (HEDS).

### *Scope and Coverage*

The Anthropological Index Online is an academic journal indexing service for anthropology. It contains over 4,000 periodical titles (1,500 current) covering all branches and areas of anthropology. Nearly 800 journals, published in more than 40 languages, are indexed on a continuing basis. Records cover 1957 to the present. It provides index only (no abstracts or full-text).

### *Kind of Information*

For a particular entry, detail bibliographic information such as title, abbreviate title, source, place of publication, present status, date of journey and closing date, notes etc. available. An example is given below:
