

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Hensley Photo Library
This collection is comprised of photographs taken during World War II by an American serviceman, Glenn S. Hensley.

American Institute of Indian Studies
The AISI collection from the Center for Art and Archaeology in Gurgaon, Haryana, India, has over 125,000 photographs in the collection. The images fall into the broad categories of architecture, sculpture, terracotta, painting and murals.

Government College of Arts and Crafts (Chennai)
The Museum of Contemporary Art, housed within the Government College of Arts and Crafts, has a photograph collection dated from the mid 1800s. The subjects of these photographs range from the hill tribes of Nilgiris to pagodas and monuments of the Madras Presidency to guns and antiques from Fort St. George.

Brief History

The South Asia Digital Library: image collections online, is a component of the Digital South Asia Library, is a bibliography of photographs. In 1993 the Sahitya Akademi (New Delhi, India) undertook a pilot project for a Catalogue of Nineteenth-Century Indian Publications. This project was critically important for planning the South Asia Union Catalogue and image database.

Scope and Coverage

It covers different types of images from various libraries including Hensley Photo Library, American Institute of Indian Studies, Government College of Arts and Crafts (Chennai), Keagle Photograph Library, Bond Photograph Library. The Hensley Photo Library's collection is comprised of photographs taken during World War II by an American serviceman, Glenn S. Hensley. The collections American Institute of Indian Studies covers over 125,000 photographs. The images fall into the broad categories of architecture, sculpture, terracotta, painting and numismatics. The Government College of Arts and Crafts (Chennai) has a photograph collection dated from the mid 1800s. The subjects of these photographs range from the hill tribes of Nilgiris to pagodas and monuments of the Madras Presidency to guns and antiques from Fort St. George. The Keagle Photograph Library's collection is comprised of photographs taken during World War II by an American serviceman, Robert Keagle. The Bond Photograph Library's collection is comprised of photographs taken during World War II by an American serviceman, Frank Bond.
