Brief History

FAOBIB i.e. FAO Online Catalogue is a multilingual, on-line catalogue of documents and publications produced by FAO since 1945, books added to the library collections since 1976, and serials held in the FAO library. The FAO websites was first released in 1995 and the first electronic workflows initiated from 1998.

Scope and Coverage

FAO is a source of knowledge and information, that helps developing countries and countries in transition modernize and improve agriculture, forestry and fisheries practices, ensuring good nutrition and food security for all. Currently FAO catalogue online covers more than 40,000 resources. It supports various languages like English, French, Spanish, Arabian, and Chinese.

Kind of Information

In case of books, each entry (hyperlinked title) provides detail bibliographic information including author name, editor name, title, other title, series, publisher name, publication year, physical description, ISBN, note, subjects, language, edition, publication place, etc. It also provides call no., accession number, holding library, report number, MFN etc. An example is given below for clear understanding.


Arrangement Pattern
