Brief History	On 5 <sup>th</sup> July, 2012 French and Italian composers gathered in the library of the Academia nationale di Santa Cecilia di Roma in Plazzo Farnese in Rome to present the "Villa of Composers" initiative. In 2010 Christophe Guyard and Marc Lys actively consulted their fellow composers and professionals to support universal access. 1st June 2013, new content has been continually added to the website of The Villa of Composers via catalogue updates and events linked to works, including works published and information on concerts and biographical information of composers. In April 2014, the composer members of the Villa of Composers Project" (USA) network, which comprises 2800 composers worldwide.
Scope and Coverage	The Villa of Composers is a private, non-profit organisation that links composers of written music with libraries. Libraries are the primary custodians of musical heritage and a gateway to promotion of musical scores. The Villa of Composers is open to numerous aesthetics of written music. The Villa of Composers is different from the Academies hosting composers in residence. It plays a complementary and lasting role in artists' lives.
