

Scope and Coverage IGM Library is one of the important central facilities of the University catering to the information needs of faculty, research scholars and students in Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, Management, Sciences and Engineering. The library has 242398 number of books, 1124 serials, 2115 thesis, 3677 Dissertations, 1858 Project Reports, 72 CD-Roms, 101 e-journals, 44 e-databases, 50 Digitized Books.

Kind of Information The library website provides separate catalogue links for separate material types:



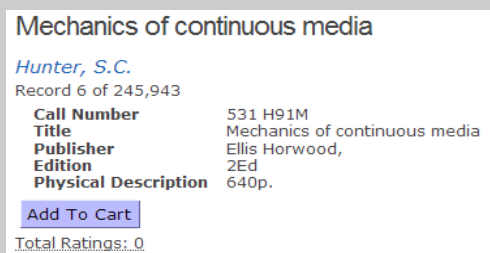
By clicking the above links one can find a search catalog for basic search and advanced search. In basic search process the user simple has to put search terms in the search bar. In advanced search process (the following screen shot) users are able to put maximum four search terms and in parallel they have to select specific bibliographic field.

The bibliographic information is also provided in MARC format and holding details are also provided.

Special Features

- The library has different digital collections. The library home page provides direct links to the materials.
- In the library home page the following search tools are provided:
 - Web of Science;
 - Scopus;
 - Indian Citation Index;
 - Royal Society of Chemistry;
 - Scifinder;
 - Math SciNet;
 - Science Direct
- Document delivery services are provided to its users.

Arrangement Pattern

The search result are arranged by relevancy to the search queries but users can rearranged the list by many options like recently added items first (chronologically), author name or titles (alphabetically), publication date (newest to oldest or oldest to newest), call number (alphanumeric), creation date (chronologically).
