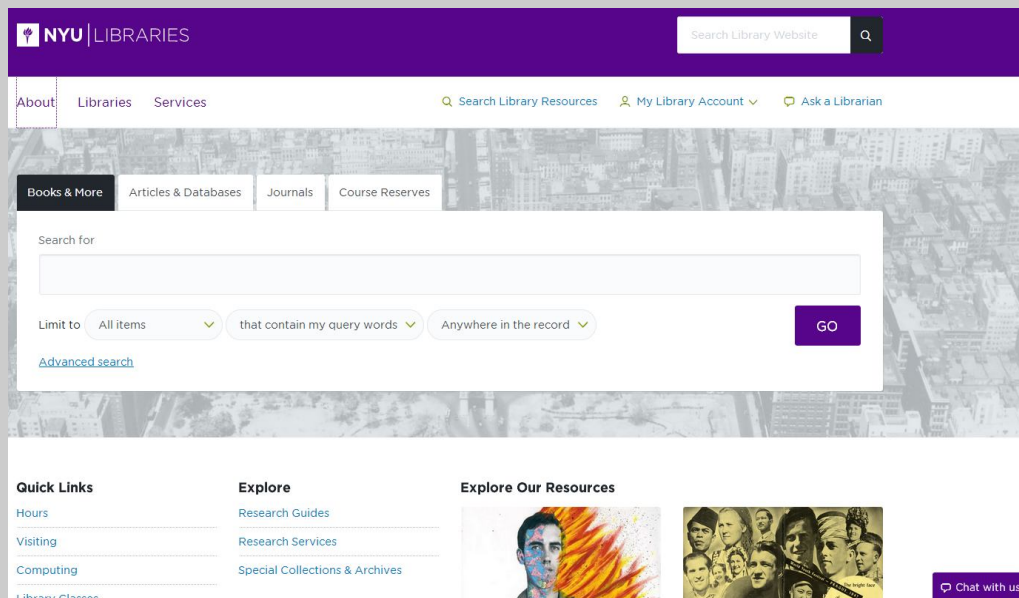

Brief History

New York University Division of Libraries (NYU Libraries) is the library system of New York University (NYU), located on the university's global campus, but primarily in the United States. It is one of the largest university libraries in the

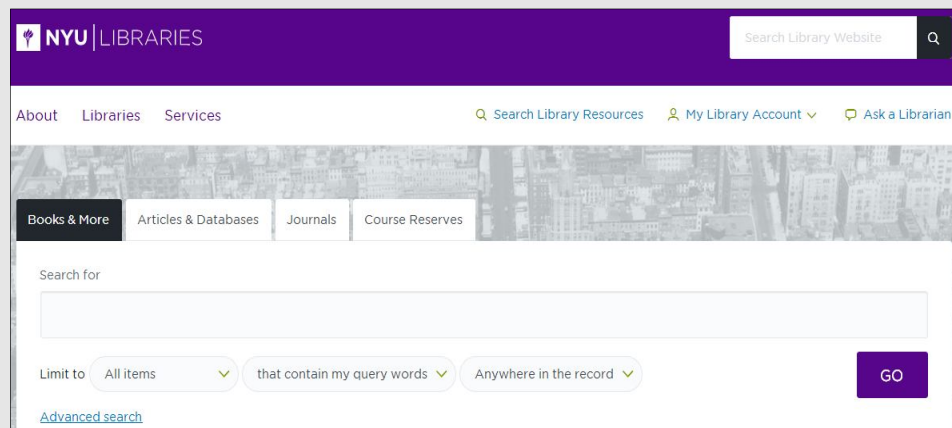
United States established in 1831.

Scope and Coverage

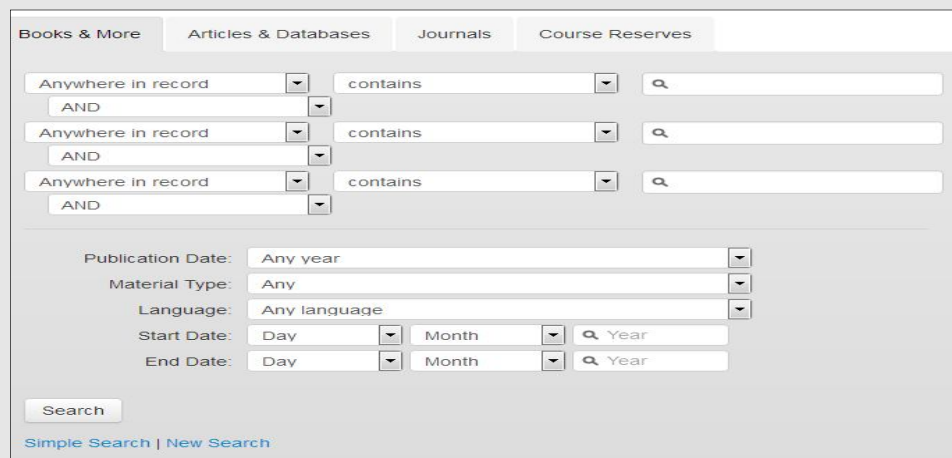
The NYU Libraries comprise five main libraries in Manhattan and one each in Brooklyn, Abu Dhabi and Shanghai. The NYU Libraries hold nearly 10 million volumes; in the search process the website separately organizes the whole university's collection into books, articles and databases, journals and course reserves. As per library record, the library annually circulates over one million books. The university library has 24 branch libraries worldwide.

Kind of Information

In basic search option, users can search for books, articles and databases, journals and course reserves individually. The search result can be sorted by the following ways:



In the advance search option, users can search for books, databases, journals, course reserves by using Boolean operators. The next screen shot shows that:



The search result may be sorted by mentioning publication date, material type, language, etc. After completing the search users can get bibliographic information.

As for example search for a book on any subject provides bibliographic information like title, publisher name, year of publication, ISBN etc.

Special Features

- Along with the search bar, there is separate option to explore university's research guides, research services, Special Collections, Archives etc.
- The website provides option to explore the collection of its branch libraries.
- Library news and updates are provided in the website regularly.
- The library has organized many classes time to time. The information is also provided.

Arrangement Pattern

The search result is arranged as per relevance of the search query. One can rearrange the list of resources according to publication date (oldest to newest or vice versa), alphabetic list of titles, authors or popularities.

Remarks

New York University is a private nonprofit research university based in New York City. It is considered one of the world's most influential research universities. The university has great collection which reflects its research works.
