### ***Scope and Coverage***

Indian Law Institute Library established in 1956, is one of the leading law libraries in Asia and attracts scholars from all over the World for legal research. The University Grants Commission has recognized the library as a place for legal research leading to doctorate degree in law and political science. From the establishment of this library it has developed its collection on all legal subjects. Library has over 78,000 documents, consisting of Books & Monographs, Treatises, Committee & Commission Reports, different Government Publications, Constitutions of all nations, Parliamentary Debates (Lok Sabha & Rajya Sabha), Gazette of India since 1962, Local Laws of all States, Acts and bills of Parliament, etc. The collection includes Foreign Legislation like US Code, Australia-Commonwealth Consolidated Act, and Canada Consolidated Statutes etc. Library is subscribing to about 220 Indian & Foreign Journals & Reports, 8 digests, 2 indexes, many rare documents.


### ***Kind of Information***

The library provides following type of search facilities for its users:

- Simple search;
- Advanced search;
- Additional search;
- Browsing of collection;
- Searching by ISBN;
- Searching by accession number;

In simple search process, users are able to search for documents by mentioning bibliographic fields like author, title, subject, ISBN, series, place of publication, publisher.


The user can make a **simple search** using this option also. The fields to be entered are Database, Field, Enter word(s) or phrase, Connector, Specify Year(s) of Publication etc. The following screen shots show it:



The search result can be sorted by the options like Title, Author, Call No., year of publication (ascending or descending) etc. The next screen shot shows it:



The above search process produces a list of relevant documents to the search query. In this list users can access limited kind of bibliographic information namely Title of the work, name of the author, call number. All the titles in that list are hyperlinked with its bibliographic information which is presented at the right side of the web page. In this format bibliographic information mainly the title, author's name, edition, publication place, year and publisher, physical description, call number, subject are provided. The next screen shot is an example:



### ***Special Features***

- The library website provides current awareness services by providing bibliographic information about new arrival books, journals.
- Through this library website, users can browse journal articles from the collection. All the titles are arranged alphabetically and hyperlinked with another web page of detail bibliographic information.
- Users are provided option to give feedback, recommendation for the library.
- There is an external link to Library Of Congress.
- The Institute has built a digital library of its collection.
- The library provides referral services to its users.

***Arrangement Pattern*** Users are given opportunity to choose pattern of arrangement of books in search list. The list can be arranged or rearranged by title or Author (alphabetical arrangement), Call No. (alphanumeric arrangement), year of publication (ascending or descending) etc.

***Remarks*** The Indian Law Institute Library in India has built a huge collection on Indian and foreign laws, many reference books, etc. The Judiciary, Central and State Government officers, various Embassies and High Commissions in Delhi have also been using the referral services of the Library. Every year thousands of law researchers from different parts of the world visit the library for research.
