Brief History UniCat is a portal that lets one search and discovers Belgian academic library collections.

Scope and Coverage


UniCat is a union catalogue of Belgian libraries. It currently holds approximately 14.5 million records from Belgian university libraries and the Royal Library and also includes the catalogues from three library networks: Anet, LIBIS-net and Boréal. UniCat focusses on academic and scientific library collections and targets both end users and library professionals.

UniCat contains about 14 million records from 46 libraries. Some of them are as follows:

The union catalog provides two search processes. In Quick search, one just has to put search term relevant to the desired documents.


