

Scope and Coverage

The University of California, Berkeley's 32 constituent and affiliated libraries together make it the fourth largest university library by number of volumes in the United States. Some of them are Doe Library, Moffitt Undergraduate Library, Main (Gardner) Stacks, The Bancroft Library, C.V. Starr East Asian Library, Engineering and physical sciences libraries, Life and health sciences libraries, Social sciences libraries, Arts and humanities libraries etc. All these libraries includes huge numbers of Guides and tutorials, Cite sources, Databases, eJournals (UC eLinks), Data/GIS, Articles, Books and e-books, Media, Course reserves.

The Guides and tutorials include Library research guides, Library workshops and tours, Government Information guides etc. The library contains **style guide** as cite sources namely APA Style guide, MLA Style Guide, Chicago Style Guide, AMA Quick Style Guide; 1251 different types of **Databases** like database of archival collections, articles, atlases, maps, gazetteers, biographical sources, book and film reviews etc.; electronic journals, data, GIS and scientific data services and software, video, audio and images.

Kind of Information

With a daily commitment to excellence and innovation, we select and create, organize and protect, provide and teach access to resources that are relevant to our campus programs and pursuits.

In the homepage of the Library Website, there is a search bar to facilitated quick search for e-journals on different subjects, databases, Library Staff Directory, Library Research Guides.



Users can search for journals, databases and staff directory, library research guide separately. Along with this simple search process there are three catalog search portals, namely 'OskiCat', 'Melvyl', 'Course Reserves'.

OskiCat

In this search portal there is an option for quick search and advanced search. The bibliographic fields like Keyword(S), Title, Author, Subjects, and Series.



Users are able to specify the collection by the material types or by the location or library names. At the right side of the search bar there is a top down menu which contains following to choose:




Under this search portal (**OskiCat**) there is advanced keyword search process. Here users can add more than one search bar and add bibliographic fields (Title, Author, Subject, Note) by 'and', 'or', 'not' operators. In this case the webpage gives direction to select more than one option. According to the website the users has to hold the control key (Windows) or the command key (⌘ Mac) and click on each one they want.

The search queries are limited to the following options:

- Locations;
- Languages;
- Books or Journals;
- Material Types;
- Electronic Resources;
- Government Publications;
- Sound Recordings;
- Video Formats;
- Scores;
- Archival Materials;
- Conference Publications;
- Microforms;
- Year of publication.

Melvyl



In this search portal users are able to search for the collection from University of California Libraries, UC Berkeley Libraries and from worldwide other libraries.

The above search process produces list of resources. In this list limited kind of bibliographic information on each document is provided, like title, author, subject, location, call number etc. All the titles are hyperlinked with another webpage where detailed bibliographic information is provided. These are language, Authors, Publication Information, Publication date, Physical Description, Series, Publication Type, Document Type, Notes, OCLC Number, Other Identifier, Accession Number, name of the database.

Special Features

- The library provides option to print, e-mail, save, cite, export, permalink, and share the document.
- The Library establishes public service policies intended to support the research, teaching and public service efforts of the University of California. All policies are intended to be in keeping with federal and state laws, and with policies issued by the UC Office of the President, and by the Chancellor, UC Berkeley.

Arrangement Pattern

By default the search result of documents are arranged by the relevancy. Users can rearrange the list by publication date (newest to oldest or vice versa).

Remarks

The UC Berkeley Library connects students and scholars to the world of information and ideas. In 2003, the Association of Research Libraries ranked it as the top public and third overall university library in North America based on various statistical measures of quality.
