

1. An inflammatory disease of the lungs characterized by (in most cases) reversible airway obstruction. Originally, a term used to mean “difficult breathing”; now used to denote bronchial asthma.

“K blood group”

Type: Term

Pronunciation: blūd grūp

Definitions:

1. See Kell blood group, in Blood Groups Appendix.

Sometimes synonyms of a particular term are also found. As for example:

“Faber anemia”

Type: Term

Pronunciation: fah'bēr

Synonyms: achlorhydric anemia

“F.R.A.C.P.”

Type: Abbreviation

Definitions:

1. Abbreviation for Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians.
