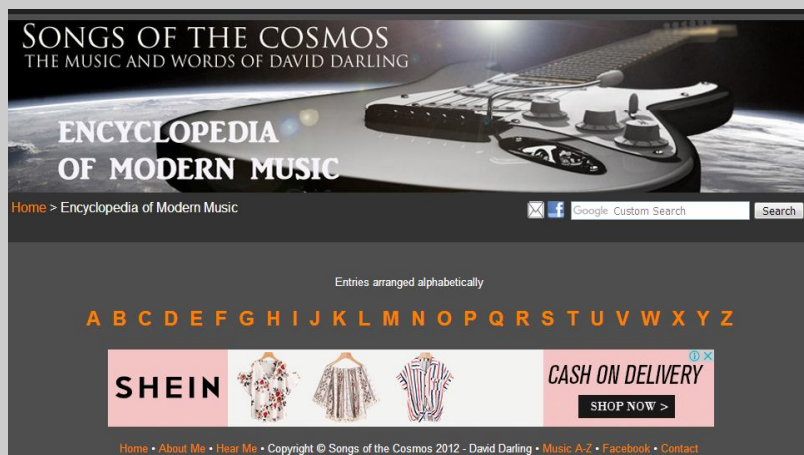
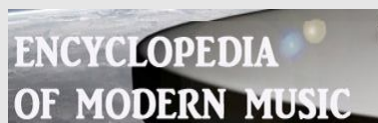

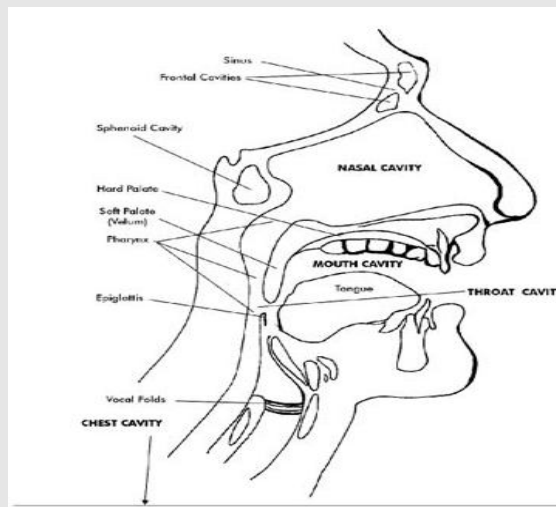
Scope and Coverage

Kind of Information

The encyclopedia is a good reference source for modern music and includes different manner of articles. As for example a category “Music Therapy” in this encyclopedia includes more than 80 articles which give information on acciaccatura, anacrusis, backbeat, chord progression, diatonic progression, harmonic progression, harmonic series, etc. A category “Scale” by its sub ordinate articles provides information on Aeolian mode, augmented scale, blues scale, chromatic scale, D harmonic minor, diminished scale, Dorian mode, harmonic minor scale, Hungarian minor scale, Ionian mode, Locrian mode, melodic minor scale, Mixolydian mode, octatonic scale, etc. An article “head voice” under category VOCAL ANATOMY includes following illustration:

The article along with above illustration includes description of head voice in terms of resonance, vocal folds, and of head voice in terms of what it sounds and feels like.
