## Scope and Coverage

This encyclopedia covers 21,980 plant entries and other articles written and edited by gardeners from around the globe, with 15,343 photos.

The plant categories include flowers, houseplants, trees, shrubs, fruits, vegetables, herbs, vines etc. In these above mentioned main categories there are further subcategories. Like the fruit category includes subcategories like **pome fruits** (apple, chokeberry, loquat, pear, quince, rowan, etc.), **berries** (blackberry, bilberry, blueberry, crowberry, cranberry, huckleberry, strawberry, etc.), **fruits of Asian region** (arhat, che, hardy kiwi, lapsi, persimmon, etc.), **fruits of American region** (American grape, American mayapple, American persimmon, buffaloberry, cocoplum, cranberry, pigeon plum, etc.), **mediterranean and subtropical fruits** (Cornelian cherry, Date palm, Fig, Grape, Black mulberry, Pomegranate, etc.), **tropical fruits** (African cherry orange, Babaco, Banana, Breadfruit, etc.), etc. and many more.

Like above instance, other plant categories are also well treated and every category has huge number of sub categories and pages (articles).

### Kind of Information

This encyclopedia is dedicated to gardening education and resources. In this reference source, the article on each type of plant starts with related facts, like the scientific name, plant height, origin, life span, needed weather, feature, flower feature etc. Then Standard Cyclopedia of Horticulture, cultivation of particular plants is also provided. The following screen shot is from an article on “Apple” plant which starts with key facts which represented in the screen shot.

### Special Features

- This is a Wiki encyclopedia where users can make a discussion on a particular topic.
- Users are able to view source code of the articles and also make a change on it.
- Edit history of the articles are also provided. But for this purpose users have to register, which is free.

The main categories are displayed in the home page under which sub categories and articles or pages under sub categories are also arranged alphabetically.
