

Brief History

The International Encyclopedia of Communication is a project that has been developed by the *International Communication Association* (ICA) and *Blackwell Publishing* (in the meantime becoming *Wiley-Blackwell*), the publisher of most ICA journals and an ICA book series. This encyclopedia came into market in March, 2008. It was published simultaneously both print and online versions to provide users with the opportunity to access this key resource in the most convenient manner. The International Encyclopedia of Communication is now regularly updated and per year adding new articles and adding new features.

At the end the articles includes list of references and suggested readings and citing style.

Arrangement Pattern

The list of entries is associated with an excel sheet at the home page of the encyclopedia and in this excel sheet there is an option to arrange all the articles chronologically according to oldest to newest and newest to oldest entries.
