This encyclopedia in its articles has covered the role of women in world history in the field of politics, sociology and many other back grounds. It also includes many other social political, cultural topics.

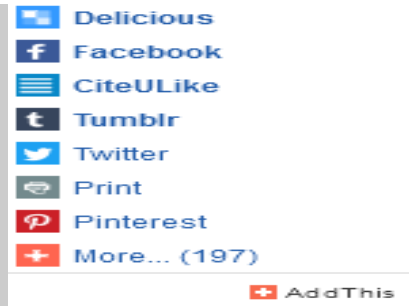

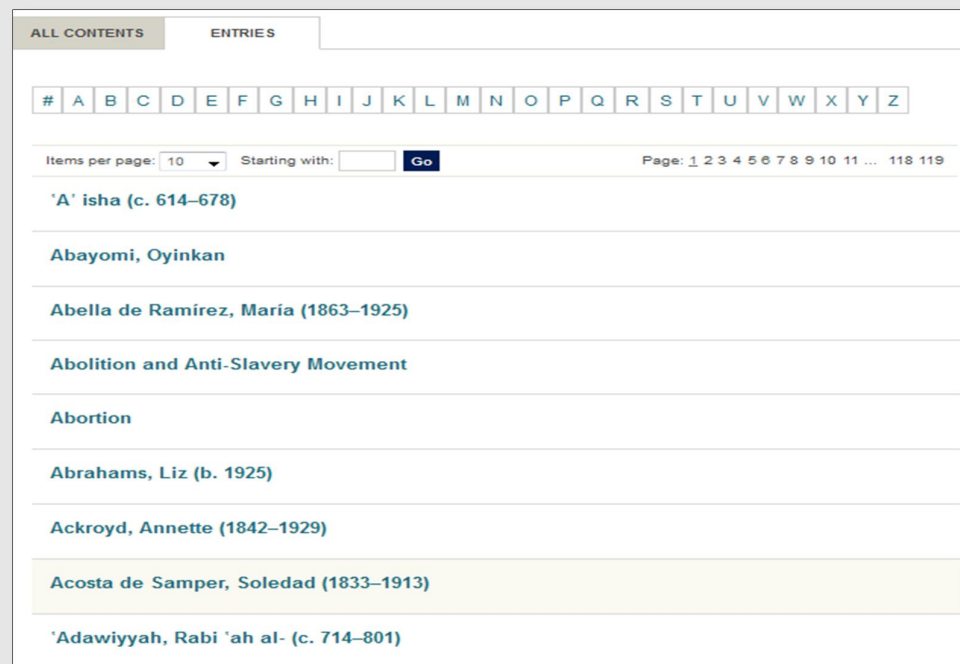
