Scope and Coverage

The purpose of this website is to provide a summary overview of the First World War. The encyclopedia currently includes some 3,100 entries. At the left hand side of the home page of this encyclopedia, there are several categories to provide information about First World War. Kind of Information

The encyclopedia provides reliable and important information on World War First and gives lengthy articles on a particular topic with lots of information under different headings. As for example the article **“The Causes of World War One”** includes different headings like Austria-Hungary's Reaction, The Tangle of Alliances, Bismarck's Greater Germany, Britain's Splendid Isolation, The Three Emperors League & Dual Alliance, The Triple Alliance, A Secret Franco-Italian Alliance, The Reinsurance Treaty, Franco-Russian Agreements, Cordial Agreements: Britain, France - and Russia, etc. and provides a great explanation on the war. The article for its support includes many photographs of those times.

Special Features

- No history of the First World War would be especially intelligible without a Who's Who gallery of its primary protagonists. This encyclopedia has a section **“Who’s Who”** for providing background information on the people who shaped events and perceptions.
- Different Multimedia files are also accommodated with the articles.
- Many of the combatants of the First World War recorded the daily events of their experiences in the form of a diary. Some were subsequently published after the war and have become

celebrated. Many more, however, remained tucked away in cupboard drawers for years, unpublished and unseen. This encyclopedia makes a possibility to read those diaries.

- The Great War inspired writers of all generations and classes, most notably among combatants. The encyclopedia also includes those prose and poetries.
- First World War spanned four years and involved many nation states. This encyclopedia has a section “Timeline” which illustrates the landmark events of the period 1914-19.

Arrangement Pattern

The encyclopedia articles on all manner of World War I material are arranged in A to Z listing in the right side of the website home page.
