

Scope and Coverage

Travellerspoint is one of the webs largest and most active travel communities with members representing every country in the world. More than 30,000 blogs have shared 175,000 stories to date and over 1.4 million photos have been posted, 50,000 accommodation booking options available on the site. The goal of Travellerspoint is to create an international meeting point for travellers worldwide, whether they are

planning their travels, currently travelling or have returned from their travels and want to stay in touch with (or find) those travel friends they met while travelling in the past.


Kind of Information

Travel point's community highlights the best content from community of travel bloggers. One can select a theme to find the interested topics, join the different groups of discussion, travel photos etc.

Entries on accommodation explores different budgeted hotels with road maps, location, information about staffs, food and beverage, ambiance, wifi facilities, breakfast, in-room facilities, spaciousness, cleanliness, spa and gym, freebies, bathroom, bedding, parking and transport, quietness, facilities, views and surroundings, whether the pets are allowed or not etc.

Trip mapping tool will let travellers plot out all their old trips, or plan new ones.

Entries on travel guide of cities include photos, map, flag, quick fact, short description, geography, regions, cities, sights and activities, event and festivals, currency, how to reach to the destination, educational Institution, language, food, health and safety, post and services etc.
