

Scope and Coverage

This is a guide to websites that provide full-text access to United States government publications and other documents. Most of the links lead directly to full-text access points, not the home pages of the sponsoring government agencies. It covers Major Government Resources of U.S, Resources by Branch of Government, Resources by Executive Department, Resources from Independent Executive Agencies and Artwork, Photographs and Other Images.

Kind of Information

Government Information on the Web provides access to U.S. Government Information Resources on the web. This is mainly a guide of United States' Government websites. In this website, there are some major topics that are mentioned in the scope and coverage area. These topics are sub-divided into sub-topics or list of guides of websites. Each sub-topic is linked to its govt. website and it also has a small description about it or what does contains within it.
