

Kitten Care Handbook

We have also included tips for people who have recently adopted a new kitten or cat, and want to make sure everything goes smoothly. Please know that if your new addition comes from a shelter, he or she is particularly at risk for illness. A shelter is a stressful environment for a cat, and their immune systems-- just like ours in times of tension-- take a dive, leaving them susceptible to whatever happens to be going around the facility's population. Even when cared for by a responsible rescue group, animals do contract unavoidable illnesses. Please be patient, know you've done a wonderful thing by adopting a rescued animal, and help your pet get a leg up (or all four) on a lifetime of good health.

Brief History

Kitten Rescue was founded in the spring of 1997 and has grown to become one of the largest and most respected animal welfare groups in Los Angeles. It is a non-profit, totally volunteer run organization devoted to finding loving new homes for unwanted cats and kittens. Kitten Rescue volunteers place approximately 1,000 cats and kittens into new homes every year. Since its inception, Kitten Rescue has rescued and placed over 10,000 cats into loving homes.

Scope and Coverage

The handbook includes the recipes and ideas for emergency kitten formula, the basic monitoring fact and unique circumstances for their health, criteria to make them healthy, food recommendations for the kitty and other related issues.

Kind of Information

The handbook provides ready to use guiding principles which are helpful in take care of cat's health. There are different kind of basic principles related to the issues like warm, clean, well hydrated, normal stools and urine of cats. The handbook also gives ideas of the principles for kittens as well as cats and discusses the unique circumstances that apply to younger kids like feeding, watering, litter pan, warning signs etc. The key in choosing a good type of food are provided under the heading food recommendations.
