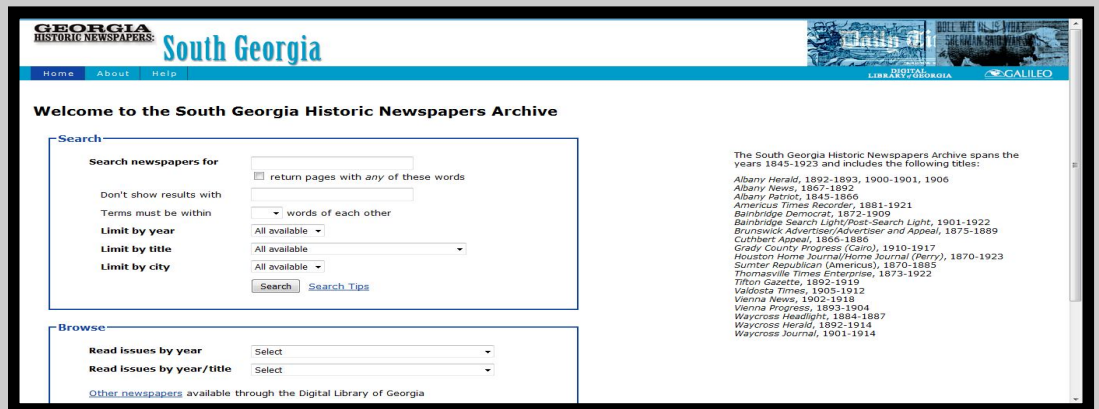
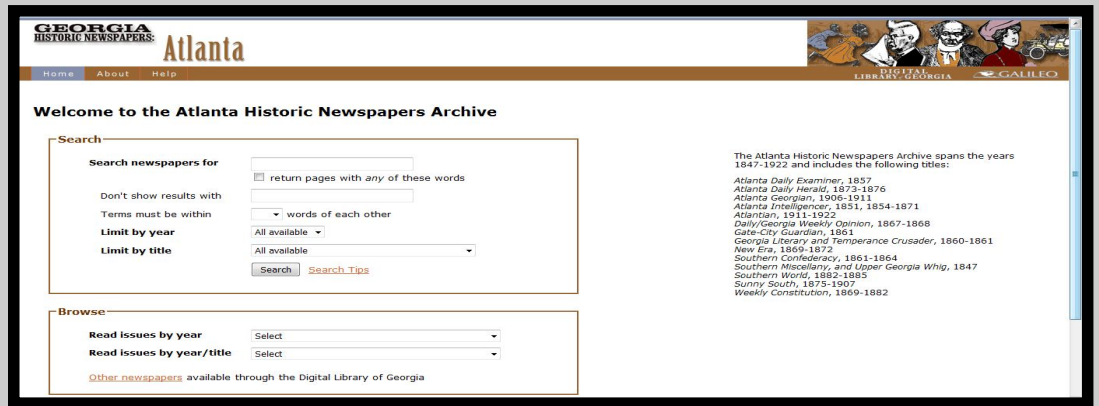

Brief History The Atlanta Historic Newspapers database and The South Georgia Historic Newspapers database is the project of the Digital Library of Georgia as part of Georgia HomePLACE. The project is supported with federal LSTA funds administered by the Institute of Museum and Library Services through the Georgia Public Library Service, a unit of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.

Scope and Coverage The Atlanta Historic Newspapers Archive spans the years 1847-1922.
The South Georgia Historic Newspapers Archive spans the years 1845-1923.

Special Features

- ❖ Some **search tips** are given for the users, these are -

All (default): All search terms occur in each page.

Any (check box): Any or all of the search terms occur in each page.

Without the words: Finds results that exclude the specified words.

Proximity: Search terms occur within the specified number of words of each other.

Truncation: Broaden the search by using an asterisk (*) or question mark (?): e.g. diplom* will find diploma, diplomatic; wom?n will find woman and women.

Exact phrase: Double-quotes ("") should be used to specify an exact search: e.g. "opera house."

- ❖ **Plug-in Requirements**

The Atlanta & South Georgia Historic Newspapers Archive is presented on the Web using images that can be viewed in any Javascript enabled web browser. No plug-in is required to view the Historic Newspapers Archive.

- ❖ **Printing and saving PDFs of page images**

To use the PDF files users will need Adobe Reader 7.0 or higher. Use the toolbar within Adobe Reader window to save or print the page image. If anyone wants to print the currently zoomed section of the page select the option for "current view" in the print dialogue. Users may need to expand the "More Options" section to see this.

- ❖ **Linking to pages**

Persistent links are provided at the top of each page. For reliable links, use these instead of copying the url from the browser's location bar.
