Brief History

The Kentucky Virtual Library, first conceived by the State-Assisted Academic Library Council of Kentucky (SAALCK), is comprised of the deans of the eight state-assisted university libraries. SAALCK's vision called for online access to the wealth of special collections materials held by Kentucky academic libraries. The 1997 Post Secondary Education Improvement Act provided funding through the Council on Post Secondary Education (CPE) to expand access to the KDL by a wider variety of libraries across the state, including public and special libraries. The Kentucky Virtual Library (KYVL) also seeks collaboration with privately funded institutions. Prior to the KYVL funding, the planning committee successfully won federal funding from the National Historical Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC) to assist in planning of implementation. KYVL selected the University of Kentucky (UK) to manage the ongoing technological infrastructure for the Kentuckiana Digital Library. In this role, University of Kentucky (UK) manages the systems infrastructure for the digital library and creates and performs digital conversion of selected archival material from around the commonwealth.

Scope and Coverage

The Kentucky Digital Library (KDL) covers historical newspapers date back from 1787 to 2013.


Kind of Information

The Kentucky Digital Library (KDL) offers broad public access to collections as a contribution to education and scholarship. Most content in the digital library is protected by the U.S. Copyright Law. Use of the materials may also be subject to other legal rights, for example, rights of publicity, privacy rights, or other legal interests. Transmission or reproduction of materials protected by copyright beyond that allowed by fair use requires the written permission of the copyright owners. As noted, additional permissions may also be required. KDL does not authorize any use or reproduction whatsoever for commercial purposes.

Apart from Historical Newspapers Kentucky Digital Library also provides some other collections. These are –

The Kentucky Digital Library makes digital versions of collections from contributing repositories accessible in the following situations:

they are in the public domain; the rights are owned by the contributing repository; contributing repositories have permission to make them accessible; materials are



made accessible for education and research purposes as a legal fair use, or; there are no known restrictions on use. Researchers should consult with contributing repositories for information about rights, contacts, and permissions. Responsibility for making an independent legal assessment of an item and securing any necessary permission ultimately rests with those persons wishing to use the item(s).

Special Features

- ❖ There is a bar which allows users to move from one page to other by selecting any number, it is helpful to quick search by overlapping from page 1 to page 100 or any others, as for example -



- ❖ A calendar view also available to search the archives by any date



- ❖ Visitors can limit their search by selecting options like any repository, any collections or any publication year.

Arrangement Pattern

Newspaper titles are arranged alphabetically; visitors can select any alphabet and search the titles with that alphabet.
