Kind of Information UKPressOnline is a professional online research facility for the public, business, re-publishers and Education and Library researchers who want to retrieve as-published pages from the back catalogues of some of the world's leading newspaper titles, including the Daily Express and Daily Mirror. UKPressOnline is what the publishers, themselves, use to search their own archives

While all users can access all available Express Newspapers titles, Public and Business access to the Mirror archive is restricted to pages from 1903-1980; only Education and Library institutions can access Mirror 1903-present.

Packages are available to all Educational and Library establishments worldwide, providing central access to educators, students and Library users.
