Scope and Coverage


Health Sociology Review is an international peer-reviewed journal, which publishes high quality conceptual and empirical research in the sociology of health, illness and medicine. Published three times per year, the journal prioritises original research papers and special issues on matters of central importance to health sociology and related fields.

Review articles are published upon occasion, but must extend conceptual understanding in health sociology, not just review what is known about a particular topic. Submissions must make a clear contribution to sociological inquiry relevant to health, but may be informed by conceptual and empirical debates from a broader range of health and social sciences. All manuscript submissions must be less than 7,500 words in length (including all text, footnotes and references). Suggestions for occasional themed special issues are welcomed. All submissions to Health Sociology Review are subject to double-blind peer review by at least two reviewers.

Kind of Information

Health Sociology Reviews contains review articles like health & medicine, fitness tracking, social rhythms of heart, how to take self-care, how to maintain fitness, girls fitness, neoliberalism, effects of smoking, child health, effects of alcohol, health reports from different countries etc.
