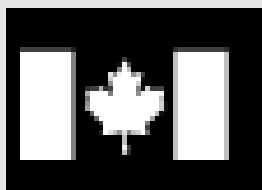

Brief History

The CGSB is one of the largest standards development and conformity assessment organizations in Canada. In business since 1934, we are a charter participant in the National Standards System (NSS) of Canada and a component of the Government of Canada, Department of Public Works and Government Services.

Scope and Coverage

CGSB is an organization within Public Works and Government Services Canada. It offers standardization products and services, including standards development, product evaluation. Accredited by the Standards Council of Canada, the CGSB offers services in Standards Development, Management Systems Programs, and Certification and Qualification Programs. Currently they are responsible for approximately 915 standards and specifications, and conformity assessment programs with over 500 customers world-wide.

Kind of Information

The Canadian General Standards Board provides standards development and conformity assessment services, including programs for certification of products and services, registration of quality and environmental management systems, and related services. These services are provided in support of economic, regulatory, procurement, health, safety and environmental interests.

Detail information about Canadian General Standards Board standards is available from the online suppliers like Techstreet, HISMarkit, Orderline, and Canadian Centre for Occupational Health and Safety. Among them Techstreet and HISMarkit provides full catalog of standards. Orderline, and Canadian Centre for Occupational Health and Safety provides only partial catalogs. The supplier named Techstreet provides their webpages on those standards. In this page, the standards are arranged under broad categories like Asbestos-cement Products, At-Sea Fisheries Observers, Blood Grouping Reagents, Brushes, Brooms and Mops, Canadian Content, Canning Devices, Decalcomanias, Doors etc. After entering those categories, the detailed information about the related standards are found. Those are full title of the standards with number code, current status, parent organization, languages, price of the printed and online edition.

Special Features

CGSB is a member of Canada's National Standards System, and is accredited by the Standards Council of Canada as a standards-development, certification, and registration organization. CGSB supports the government's economic, regulatory, procurement, health and safety interests.

Arrangement Pattern

Canadian General Standards Board standards are available from the above mentioned online suppliers. Among them Techstreet and HISMarkit provides full catalogs of all related standards. HISMarkit has listed all the standards in alphabetic order. But Techstreet arranges all the standards under main alphabetic list of main categories and then under each category the standards have alphanumeric arrangement.
