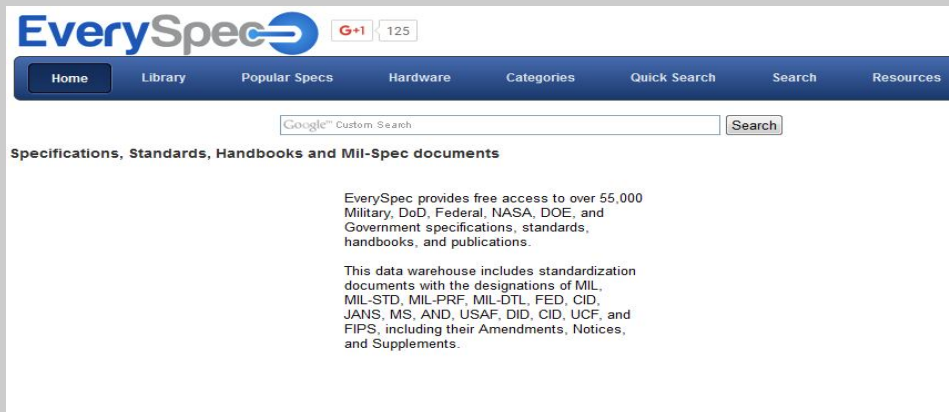

Scope and coverage

The Every Spec provides free downloads of government and military standards, specifications, handbooks, and documents. This site is created to locate and search for the specifications, standards, handbooks, and documents that are in public domain information, and yet are hard to find, search, and index. Among them the Defense Specification includes the document that describes the essential technical requirements for purchased material that is military unique or substantially modified commercial items. MIL-STD-961 covers the content and format for defense specifications. The defense standard includes document that establishes uniform engineering

and technical requirements for military-unique or substantially modified commercial processes, procedures, practices, and methods. There are five types of defense standards: interface standards, design criteria standards, manufacturing process standards, standard practices, and test method standards. Performance Specification includes performance specification states requirements in terms of the required results with criteria for verifying compliance, but without stating the methods for achieving the required results. A performance specification defines the functional requirements for the item, the environment in which it must operate, and interface and interchangeability characteristics. The detail specification: A specification that specifies design requirements, such as materials to be used, how a requirement is to be achieved, or how an item is to be fabricated or constructed. A specification that contains both performance and detail requirements is still considered a detail specification.

<b><i>Kind of Information</i></b>	This is a source for free downloads of government and military standards, specifications, handbooks, and documents. The standards and specifications include information like the name of the standard or standard, title, issuing date, small introduction and scope of the standard and specification. Each entry provides the facility to freely download the pdf file on that standard or specification. This pdf file includes the information like the scope, purpose, applicability and key terminology used in this standard. Also the entry includes the status of the standard or specification (whether it is active or cancelled), FSC code and version of that product.
<b><i>Special Features</i></b>	Along with the standards and specifications, the website also includes handbooks. The Defense Handbook Guidance document contains standard procedural, technical, engineering, or design information about the materiel, processes, practices, and methods covered by the Defense Standardization Program (DSP).
<b><i>Arrangement Pattern</i></b>	The standards and specifications are arranged in ascending orders by the numbers associated the name of the standards and specifications.
<b><i>Remarks</i></b>	This website along with the standards and specifications also includes handbooks related to the military services of United States.
