Brief History


FedStats is considered as a trusted source for federal statistical information since 1997.

Scope and Coverage

FedStats provides access to the full range of official statistical information produced by the Federal Government without having to know in advance which Federal agency produces which particular statistic. With convenient searching and linking capabilities to more than 100 agencies it provides data and trend information on such topics as economic and population trends, crime, education, health care, aviation safety, energy use, farm production and more. FedStats is considered as the platform for access to the full breadth of Federal statistical information. Data from the Federal Statistical System is available through APIs, web, and mobile applications.

Kind of Information

This federal statistical system is decentralized, spanning 127 agencies spread across the government, all of which are engaged in collecting data and producing statistics. Some topics are discussed including photographs and brief description under the heading “showcase”. One example is shown below:



In the ‘resources and standards’, statistical policy working papers are kept which include training for the future: addressing tomorrow’s survey tasks, federal longitudinal surveys (1986), contracting for surveys (1983), statistical interagency agreements (1982), report on statistics for allocation of funds (1978) etc.

News are given on different topics like federal registers, economic and financial indicators and information on USA.gov is available also.

Statistical information are given on the following:

- ❖ planning of statistical surveys and studies, including project design, sample design and selection, and design of questionnaires, forms, or other techniques of observation and data collection,
- ❖ collection, processing, or tabulation of statistical data for publication, dissemination, research, analysis, or program management and evaluation,
- ❖ publication or dissemination of statistical data and studies,
- ❖ methodological testing or statistical research,
- ❖ data analysis,
- ❖ statistical tabulation, dissemination, or publication of data collected by others

- ❖ construction of secondary data series or development of models that are an integral part of generating statistical series or forecasts,
- ❖ Statistical operations, statistical consulting or training and so on.

Special Features

- Any item can be searched by entering keywords in the search box.
- Statistical programmes are given in PDF format and those can be downloaded.
- Links of some important agencies like NCHS, NCSES, OEI, ORES, SOI are attached here.
- Some showcase videos can be seen also.
- RSS Feed facility can be seen.
