### **Brief History**

### **Scope and Coverage**

Indiastat.com is a cluster of 56 associate websites wherein 19 websites are sector-specific, 6 are regional websites and 31 websites are state-specific. Subscribing Indiastat.com will give an automatic access of its 56 associate sites. Indiastat.com contains all the statistical information available on its 56 associate websites. However data is made available separately on these 56 associate sites just for an ease of navigation.

There are 33 socio-economic categories which are given with particular icons and brief description as shown below:





In "Infographics" different topics are discussed with related maps and graphical representations. Such as:


