Brief History


Statistics South Africa has produced three censuses, in 1996, 2001 as well as the results of the 2011 Census were released. Stats SA was previously known as the "Central Statistical Service"; shortly after the end of apartheid it absorbed the statistical services of the former Transkei, Bophuthatswana, Venda and Ciskei.

Scope and Coverage


Statistics South Africa produces official demographic, economic, and social censuses and surveys. All prospective suppliers within the South African government are encouraged to self-register on the Central Supplier Database. The self-registration application represents an expression of interest from the supplier to conduct business with the South African government. It is engaged to produce official statistics and places great importance on data quality, to ensure that its statistical products and services satisfy user needs.

Kind of Information

Statistics can be seen by place. Population statistics can be seen from 2011 census report. A map is given here, from which population of different places can be known by placing the cursor on specific region. Example is shown below:



It gives description on mining including related statistics and links of reference articles. Statistics is looked like:
