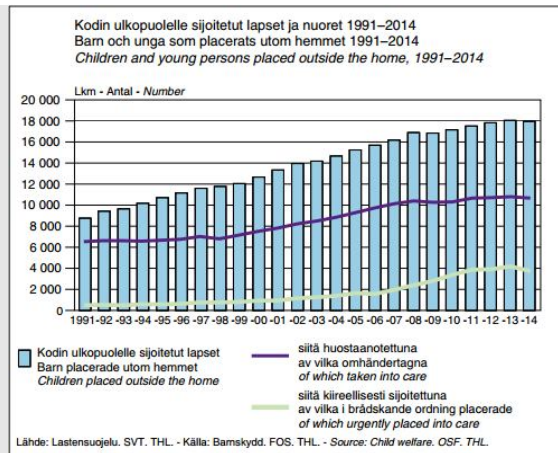

<i>Brief History</i>	In the year 2000, the publication started its journey aiming to provide the most important statistical information about welfare and health and the system of social and health services in Finland.
<i>Scope and Coverage</i>	The Statistical Yearbook contains the key statistical data on social welfare and health care, grouped according to themes. The data are presented in the form of time series, with the data on the last year in the times series classified according to region or hospital district. The section on monitoring indicators at the end of the Statistical Yearbook facilitates monitoring of national programmes in the social welfare and health care sector. The yearbook is specially designed to be used in social and health care administration, development and research.
<i>Kind of Information</i>	<p>The yearbook begins with an outline of social welfare and health care trends in Finland in the past few years. It is organized according to themes defined by phases of life and by service sector. A summary of follow-up indicators is provided at the end of the yearbook.</p> <p>The yearbook is thoroughly filled with statistical data represented through short paragraphs, tables and graphs. In a section named “Services for children and families”, the domains of “Child day care”, “Child welfare” and “Maintenance allowance” have been described. The “Child day care” section says about the number of children of a specific age group, staying in municipal day care facility, its numerical difference with children within family care, the amount of children increased in day care with reference to previous year.</p> <p>The language of the yearbook comes in Finnish, Swedish and English language consecutively, i.e. each section of the book is found in all the three language in consecutive pages. At the end of a section graphical representation of the mentioned statistical data are provided. Following is an example:</p>

Explanation of symbols, Definition of terms including diseases, services, explanation of concepts, description of data sources, maps, regional classification etc are provided at the last of the yearbook. Some specimens of the said items are mentioned next:

Definition

Exercise: For the purposes of the School Health Promotion Study, people who do little or no exercise that leaves them out of breath are defined as those people who, in the course of a week, usually do one hour, half an hour or no exercise at all that leaves them out of breath. For the purposes of the study on Health Behaviour and Health among the Finnish Adult Population, people who do little or no exercise are defined as those who did at least half an hour of exercise that made them hot and out of breath, but no more than once a week. For the purposes of the study on Health Behaviour and Health among the Finnish Retirement-Age Population, people who do little or no exercise or walking are defined as those who, in the course of a week,

walked outdoors for no more than half an hour and did exercise other than walking (e.g. skiing, cycling, swimming, gymnastics, team sports, dancing) no more than 23 times a month for at least half an hour.

Sources

Access to services in specialised health care. THL. The statistics contain data by specialty on waiting times for admission to elective treatment, waiting times for assessment of the need for treatment as well as on referral processing times in hospital districts and specialised health care units in primary health care. The statistical report has also data on waiting times for the most common groups of surgical procedures. Data are collected three times a year and published in electronic database reports. Data have been collected from hospital districts since December 2007 and from specialised health care units in primary health care since December 2008.
